USING THE SCHOOLS' OWN "NET PRICE CALCULATOR" PROGRAMS, WITH 2018/2019 HARD COSTS (TUITION & FEES AND ROOM & BOARD) AND TYPICAL SOFT COSTS (BOOKS & SUPPLIES, PERSONAL EXPENSES, AND TRAVEL COST). BASED ON FINANCIAL DATA FROM AN AMERICAN FAMILY OF FOUR WITH AN ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME OF \$60,000 AND LIMITED ASSETS. TOTAL GRANTS INCLUDE NO LOANS, AND THEY ARE NEED-BASED ONLY AT BOTH HARVARD AND BERKELEY.
